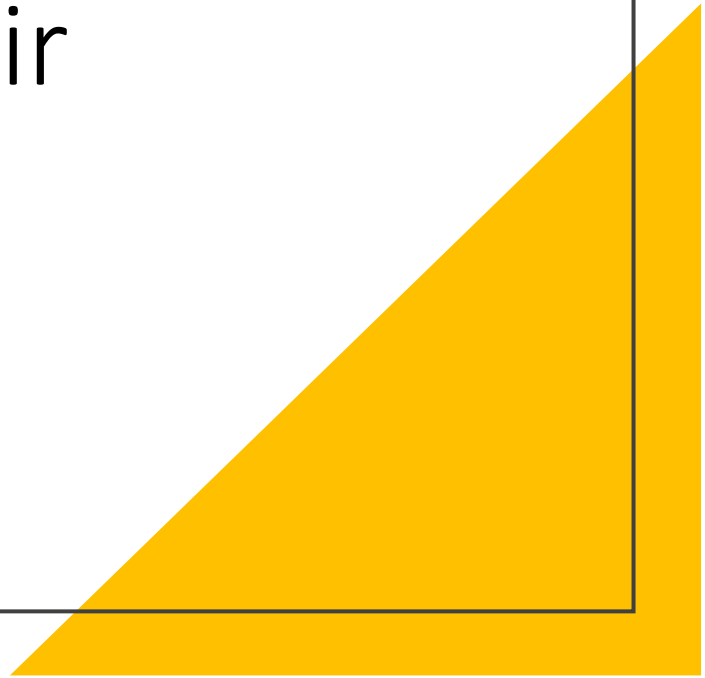

As a District Partner student, your child remains a student of your home district in every way. You will complete state testing with your home district. All special programs will remain the responsibility of your home district (IEP/504/TAG/ELD). They continue to have access to programs within your home district (i.e. sports), please reach out to your district for details of their options and access.

We are a provider to your district allowing your child to access our classes and social opportunities. Your child will work directly with our teachers and staff, and we will provide updates on progress and attendance to your district.

# Learning Options at Evergreen

Fully Online or Hybrid with in person learning in your District

## **K-8 Model with live instruction**

- Online curriculum with live teacher instruction daily
- Assignments completed after live classes, with support of the parent
- Ongoing support from Engagement Coach, as well as orientation support
- Virtual and in person social activities
- Live teacher help sessions and at times small group support
- Supplemental curriculum and diagnostic assessments
- Students can attend full time or half time
- Half time students are considered hybrid and attend some classes in person as well, make sure to talk to your district about choosing this option
- Students with live classes can expect to have 2+ hours per day in class

## **K-8 independent study (Homeschool Model)**

- Online curriculum with parent supported learning
- Independent study model for home school minded families
- Teacher consultation
- Students must be able to access grade level curriculum
- Focus on power standards so parents can build a flexible day and add in any other learning opportunities they choose
- Access to Evergreen in person social activities
- Support for orientation to learn the platforms and get started
- Must demonstrate ongoing learning to continue in this model
- Requires weekly form to gain attendance
- No live teacher instruction, fully supported by the guardian with teacher oversight to ensure progress toward standards
- Students can attend full time or half time (half time should be approved by district)

## **High School Model**

- Most High School courses come with live classes
- Students will work through online curriculum and attend live classes or help sessions daily
- Select High School courses are offered as independent study. These courses come with live help sessions with a teacher (different from the K-8 independent study model)
- Students require learning coach (parent) support to ensure they are organized, progress in the curriculum and turning in assignments
- Students can attend full time or part time
- Part time would be taking 1 or more courses and should be approved by the district
- Part time students are considered hybrid and attend some classes in person as well, make sure to talk to your district about choosing this option
- The students HS counselor in their district should choose courses they need to take
- Full time students in HS can expect to attend 2-4 hours per day of live classes
