- ✓ Attend school Monday-Friday

- ✓ Complete lessons on calendar
- ✓ 23-25 hours of academic work each week
- ✓ Complete all assessments
- ✓ Communicate regularly with the school

- Log in to Canvas
- Check your Schedule or the Calendar to know what lessons need completed and what Class Connect Sessions need attended
- Check Grades tab daily and look at each subject's grades to catch any missing work
- Check Canvas Inbox a few times throughout the day
- Check for voicemails and return phone calls to school
- Stay in communication with your teacher & engagement coach

Learning Coach (parent) Responsibilities

The role of the learning coach (parent) is essential to the success of the student in the online setting

- ✎ Daily monitoring of student with going to class
- ✎ Guide student through lessons as needed but allow them to complete graded work on their own.
- ✎ Daily interaction with student to ensure active engagement
- ✎ Ensure consistent academic progress
- ✎ Check emails daily and respond as required in a timely manner
- ✎ Check voicemails and return any missed calls from the school



Suggestions to the Learning Coach (parent) to help student have a successful school year

- **Develop a schedule/routine and be consistent**
 - **Have a reward/incentive system**
- **Check the grades regularly to catch any missed lessons**
 - **Print a visual schedule of required sessions**
 - **Print out weekly calendar**
 - **Print weekly goals and expectations**
